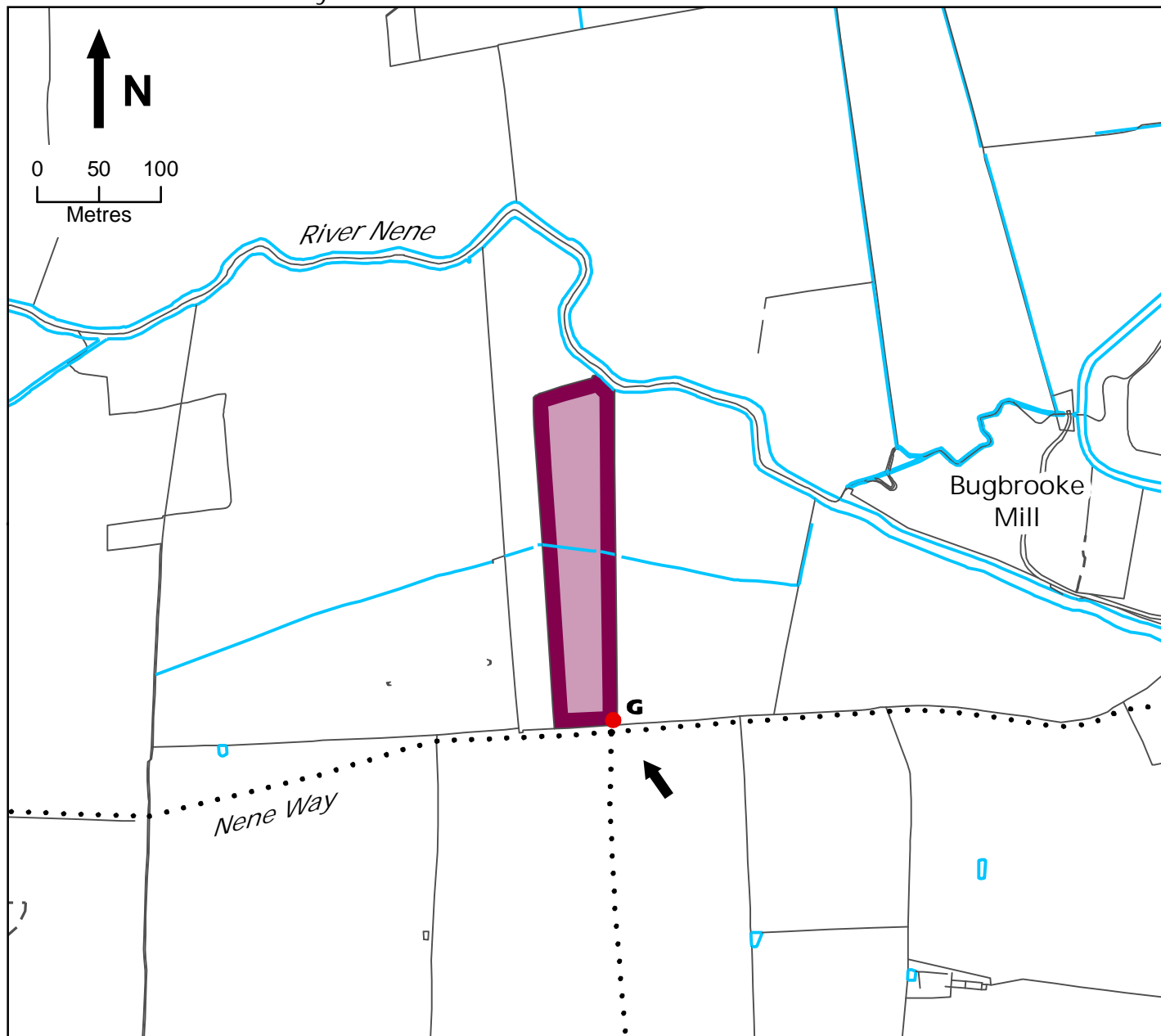


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

The site contains a group of low lying meadows alongside the River Nene which have escaped drainage and improvement. They tend to flood in winter and often remain wet well into the growing season. As a result they support a range of damp grassland communities which are remarkably diverse and rich in species. The grassland is of the crested dog's tail marsh marigold flood pasture type, grading through meadow foxtail great burnet to crested dog's tail knapweed on the drier areas. In some wetter places the creeping bent marsh foxtail community occurs.
