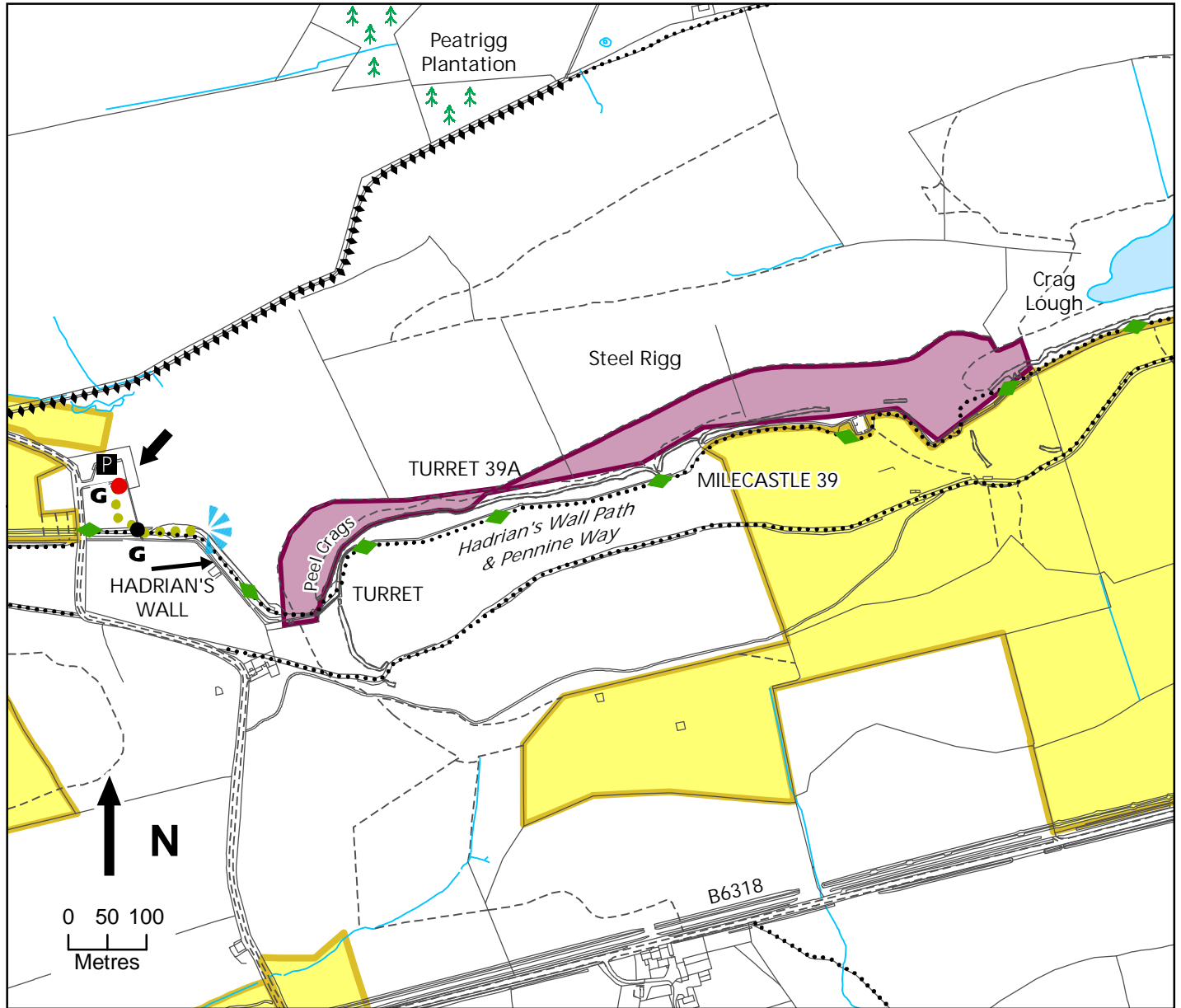


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

A hard surfaced path leads from the car park, through 2 gates, and along the National Trail for a short distance to a viewpoint of Crag Lough and surrounding area. Please note this is a working livestock farm and gates should be kept shut. Access to the base of the crags for agreed climbing activities is also allowed. Please note that the site is designated on a national and international level for its historic features, geology and biodiversity so care should be taken not to cause any damage. Do not walk on top of Hadrian's Wall itself. If you have any concerns please contact the National Trust at Housesteads who are the landowners.
