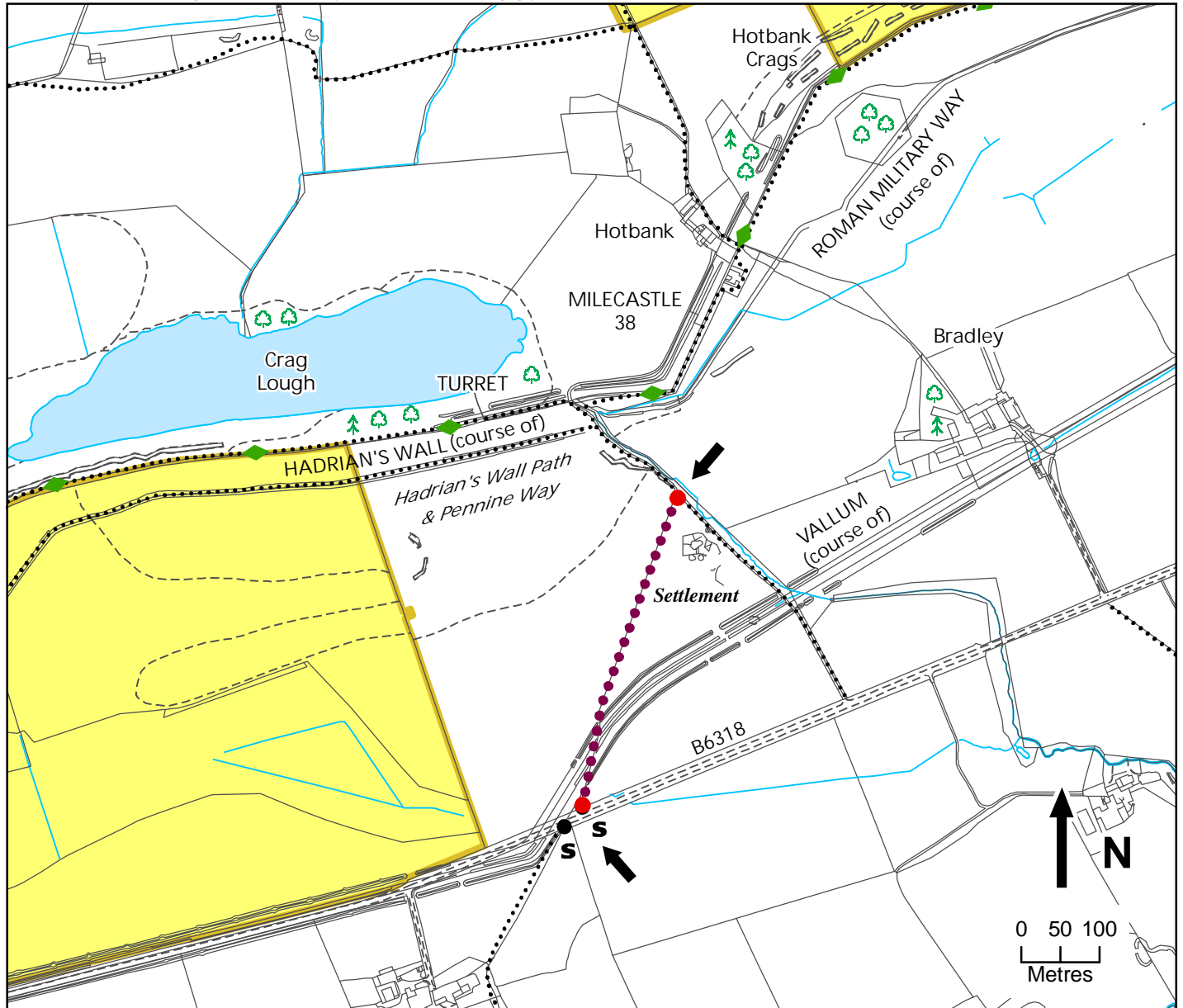


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

A link is provided as an alternate to walking along the military road to join up with other rights of way. From the road, cross the stile and walk along the short boardwalk section, before heading in a north east direction, to the left of the distinctive earthworks of the Hadrian's Wall Vallum, towards the track that crosses the National Trail at Milking Gap. From the track from Milking Gap and Hotbank Farm, follow the Vallum across the field in a south west direction to a short section of boardwalk across a wet flush area before crossing the stile to the military road. Please note this is a working livestock farm and the ground may also be boggy in winter months.
